The Breath Test Device (Approval) (Scotland)
Order 1968

The device known as the Alcotest, comprising an indicator tube (marked with the name "Alcotest"), mouth piece and measuring bag, and supplied to police forces in Scotland in a container marked with the name "ALCOTEST ©80".
