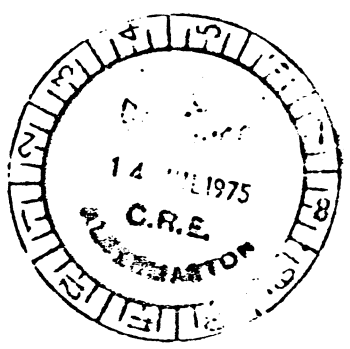
The Breath Test Device (Approval) (No. 1) Order 1975
